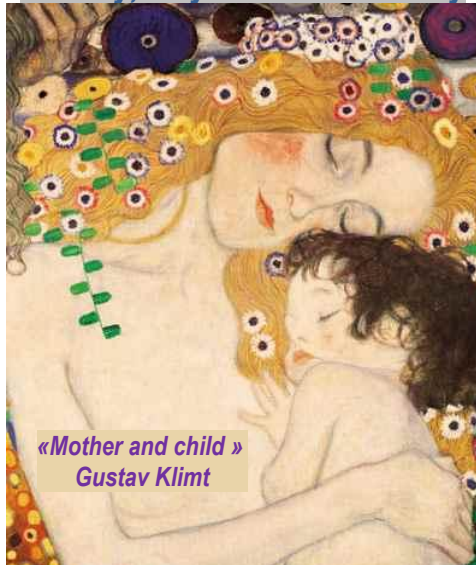
### Between making money or making people happy,
